A word from our Tumuaki

Dear Parents and Whānau,

Today, we are sharing your child's end of year summative comment and achievement graphs with you through Hero. The teachers have spent a lot of time putting these together but if there are any typo's or other issues or concerns, please contact us so that we can look at them to see if any changes need to be made.

Over the last few weeks, the staff have worked closely together to organise the class placements for each child. As part of this process, we take into account a whole range of factors which includes social relationships, class numbers, gender balance, ethnicity and making sure that they are placed with children that they know and are likely to learn best with. On Monday, the children will be spending some time with their 2025 teacher so that they know who this will be and which room they are in. We do this so that this is not a source of worry for them over the summer break.

Next Tuesday, we will officially farewell our Year 6 students at a ceremony in Te Whau. The library gate will be open from 12.30pm and family members are asked to arrive and be seated by 12.50pm.

Tomorrow, we will provide more details for how the school will be organised next year. The most noticeable change will be the arrangement of the classes into two teams (currently 5) that will be known as Rimu for Years 0-3 and Kauri for Years 4-6. Part of the reason for this is that the new curriculum documents are clearly split on these grounds and we felt that this would make the teaching and learning clearer for everyone. We are strongly committed to the philosophy of teaching children at the levels that they are at and we still do everything we can to align our teaching to this.

We will publish the last newsletter for the year next Thursday. Have a great week everyone!


MEDICATION HELD AT SCHOOL OFFICE
