

- · WINZ forms need to be submitted when making your booking, a 25% deposit is required to confirm.

About Manu Group Organisation at Blockhouse Bay

At Blockhouse Bay Primary School each Manu group (class) is able to learn alongside another Manu group in a flexible learning space with two teachers. We would like to share some of the benefits of learning in this way:

- Children have more time learning individually or in small groups e.g. One teacher is supervising a learning task and providing individual support while the other is teaching individuals or small groups
- Learners gain from the strengths and interests of at least two teachers.
- Learners diverse needs are met more effectively as the teachers work together to support each student
- Teachers work collaboratively to plan for and implement the learning for the children. They share strengths and support one another to be the best teachers possible
- If one of the two teachers is away, the remaining teacher can help guide the relieving teacher to ensure that the learning programme continues with minimal changes for the children


