

Bring your own Device: Chromebook Agreement

My child is bringing their own chromebook to school for use in the classroom learning programme.

I understand that:

- My child must follow the school rules: Manaakitanga Be kind, Be honest, Be respectful, when using their chromebook.
- My child is responsible for looking after their chromebook and the insurance for the device is my responsibility.
- While the school will support the children, the school holds no responsibility for any loss or damage which might occur.
- Teachers will provide a designated storage space where the child's chromebook is stored when not in use.
- Children should bring their chromebook to school each day fully charged.
- The chromebook is brought to school for the use of my child only.
- During collaborative group work, my child will share his/her screen with others however my child is in charge of his/her chromebook.
- Children will use cloud based applications such as Google Drive for file management and are allowed to access this at home with parent permission.
- My child will still use pen and paper as part of their learning in addition to the purposeful use of their device.
- Rules governing the use of any school-owned chromebooks will apply to student owned chromebooks while they are at school. This includes adherence to the Copyright Act and School Internet Safety Policy.
- The device will be subject to internet filtering while connected to the school wireless network.
