For your information

- Girls and boys sleep in separate areas
- Trained instructors lead activities at camp
- Adult ratio is between 1:4 and 1:6 adults to students, depending on the activity
- Venue is OSH approved

Adult Helpers on Camp

- Some adults, usually parents, come on camp to assist with activities and other jobs
- They help make up the ratios
- Are police checked
- If you are keen, fill out the google form when it is published
- Names drawn from a ballot in December

What do Adult helpers do?

- Supervise a small group of children (not their own child)
- Give every activity a go
- Encourage independence in your own child and others
- Assist with food preparation, serving, cleaning and anything else!
- Support the decisions of camp staff/teachers

Cost

Camp will cost approximately \$320 per child. This includes transport by bus, 2 nights accommodation, meals and activities.
